The **West Bragg Creek All Season Trail Plan** was created to improve non-motorized trail users' experience with the development of a sustainable multi-use summer and winter trail system, while minimizing the environmental impact of recreational use.

## Since September 2010:

- 72 km of new trails have been completed; 22 km of trails have been upgraded
- \$720,000 in funding has been raised and spent
- 14,000 volunteer hours have been donated
- 130,000 visitors/ year (triple, since implementation of the West Bragg Creek All Season Trail Plan)

The **GBCTA** has transformed this popular 130km WBC Trail System into a **world class recreational trails destination**, leaving a lasting legacy for future generations. Many Albertans are enjoying the recreation, health and economic benefits of the new trails that were created by the GBCTA and are maintained in partnership with Alberta Parks.

To connect this new and improved trail network, the GBCTA is working to complete the TransCanada Trail between Bragg Creek and Kananaskis Country. Celebrating today as well, Phase 1 was just completed, cost = \$400,000. Next steps: Phase 2 and 3 to be constructed before 2017. Help us realize this goal today!

The GBCTA was incorporated as an Alberta not for profit Society in 2004 and as a federally registered charity in 2007. The mission of the GBCTA is "to develop and maintain trails in the Bragg Creek Area for public recreation."
